Homestead Certificate No. 1349

Whereas, there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Jackson Minnesota, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *Gustavus Claude* has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the West half of the North West quarter, and the West half of the South West quarter of Section five in Township one hundred and three of Range twenty six, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Jackson Minnesota containing one hundred and sixty one acres, and six hundredths of an acre Except paid as per receipt No. 6785

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Gustavus Claude* the tract of Land above described: **To Have and to Hold** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Gustavus Claude* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, *J. Ulysses Grant*, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
