To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States an Order of the Secretary of the Interior directing that a fee simple patent issue to ALICE CLOUD, or Oo see ah kaw, a Winnebago Indian, for the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section thirty-two in Township twenty-seven north of Range six east of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Nebraska, containing forty acres,

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Alice Cloud, and to her heirs, the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Alice Cloud, and to her heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, **Theodore Roosevelt**, President of the

United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
