To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimants, Alice Cloud and Sarah Nestling, pursuant to the Act of May 14, 1948 (62 Stat. 236), for the following described land:

Fifth Principal Meridian, Minnesota.

T. 143 N., R. 30 W.,

Sec. 7, Lot 10, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ .

The area described contains 76.35 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimants and to their heirs the Land above described, in accordance with the terms of said Order to wit: to Alice Cloud, an undivided 1/2 interest; and to Sarah Nestling, an undivided 1/2 interest; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimants and to their heirs and assigns forever.
