To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management, directing that a fee simple patent issue to Charlotte Barber Carroll, Antoine Cloud, and Pish e waince, heirs of Oke mah ke shig, for the following described land:

Fifth Principal Meridian, Minnesota.

T. 115 N., R. 40 W.,

Sec. 15, ~~NE~~^{NE}₄.

The area described contains 80 acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the Bureau of Land Management.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Charlotte Barber Carroll, Antoine Cloud, and Pish e waince, and to their heirs, the Land above described; according to the terms of the said order to wit: to Charlotte Barber Carroll, an undivided $\frac{1}{4}$ interest; to Antoine Cloud, an undivided $\frac{1}{4}$ interest; and to Pish e waince, an undivided $\frac{2}{4}$ interest; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Charlotte Barber Carroll, Antoine Cloud, and Pish e waince, and to their heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of June 17, 1948 (62 Stat., 476), has, in the name of the United States, caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the Bureau to be hereunto affixed.
