issued in favor of *George Cloud, Second Lieutenant, in Captain Bishop's Com-*  
*-pany, Major Nelson's Regiment, Georgia Volunteers. -*  
*Florida War.*

*South West quarter of the North East quarter, the South East quarter of the*  
*North West quarter, and the East half of the South West quarter of Section*  
*thirty five, in Township sixty eight, North, of Range sixteen, West, in the*  
*District of Lands subject to sale at Fairfield, Iowa, containing one Hun-*  
*-dred and sixty acres.*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by  
the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

*George Cloud,*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances  
thereof, unto the said *George Cloud, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
