To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas Hannah A. Cloud of Wilson County, Kansas,

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Humboldt, now Independence, Kansas, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Hannah A. Cloud,

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

and the Act of the 15th of July, 1870; for the west half of the north west quarter of Section twenty four, and the east half of the north east quarter of Section twenty three, in Township thirty south, of Range sixteen east, in the District of Lands formerly subject to sale at Humboldt, now Independence, Kansas, containing one hundred and sixty acres,

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been purchased by the said Hannah A. Cloud,

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Hannah A. Cloud,

and to her heirs, the said tract above described: To have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said Hannah A. Cloud

and to her heirs and assigns forever.
