To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States an Order of the Secretary of the Interior directing that a fee simple patent issue to **HENRY CLARENCE CLOUD, or CON-NO-KAW,** a Winnebago Indian, for the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section twelve in Township twenty-six north of Range six east of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Nebraska, containing forty acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said **Henry Clarence Cloud** and to **his** heirs, the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said **Henry Clarence Cloud** and to **his** heirs and assigns, forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, **Theodore Roosevelt**, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
