To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, an Order from the Secretary of the Interior, accompanied by a Schedule of Allotments of land for certain Indians of La Pointe, or Bad River Reservation, as contemplated by the Treaty concluded September 30, 1854, with Chippewa Indians of Lake Superior and the Mississippi, and subsequent legislation, including the Act of Congress approved August 1, 1914, whereby it appears that Ida F. Cloud has been allotted the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the south half of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section twenty in Township forty-six north of Range two west of the Fourth Principal Meridian, Wisconsin, containing sixty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the Treaty and Act of Congress aforesaid, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Ida F. Cloud, and to her heirs, the tract above described; but with the stipulation that the said Ida F. Cloud or her heirs, shall not sell, lease, or in any manner alienate said tract without the consent of the President of the United States; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Ida F. Cloud, and to her heirs and assigns, forever, with the stipulation as aforesaid.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, **Woodrow Wilson**

President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
