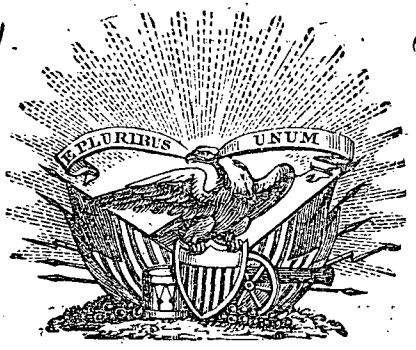

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 18294 for 40 acres, issued in favor of Isaac Cloud, Sergeant in Captain Houston's Company, Tennessee Militia, War 1812.

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section Eleven in Township Six of Range Nine, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Lebanon Alabama, containing Forty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: which has been assigned unto Vance B. Sarmore

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Vance B. Sarmore

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Vance B. Sarmore and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
