TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME/ GREETING:

That, in pursuance of the Acts of Congress, appropriating and granting Land to the late Army of the United States, passed on and since the sixth day of May, 1812, *Septua Cloud*

having deposited in the General Land-Office a Warrant in *his* favor, numbered *472* there is granted unto *the said Septua Cloud* late a *Private in* *Marquis* *Cornp 9 22^o Regt of Infantry* a certain Tract of Land, containing *one hundred and thirty six* being the *south* *west* *corner* of Section *Twenty one* of Township *Thirteen* in Range *Five East* in the Tract appropriated (by the Acts aforesaid) for Military Bounties, in the Territory of *Illinois* (his) TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *one hundred and thirty six* Section of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Septua Cloud* and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.
