The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the authorized officer of the Bureau of Indian Affairs is now deposited in the Bureau of Land Management, directing that, pursuant to the Act of April 23, 1904 (33 Stat. 297), a trust patent issue to Jessie Cloud; Crow Allottee No. 249, for the MINERALS ONLY, including coal, oil and gas, in the following described land:

Principal Meridian, Montana

T. 3 S., R. 32 E.,

Sec. 25, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$.

The area described contains 40.00 acres.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, hereby declares that it does and will hold the said minerals, including coal, oil and gas, in the land above-described (subject to all statutory provisions and restrictions) for the period of twenty-five years, in trust for the sole use and benefit of the said Indian, and at the expiration of said period, the United States will convey the same by patent to the said Indian in fee discharged of said trust and free from all charge and encumbrance whatsoever; but in the event said Indian dies before the expiration of said trust period, the Secretary of the Interior shall ascertain the legal heirs of said Indian and either issue to them in their names a patent in fee for said minerals, or cause said minerals to be sold for the benefit of said heirs as provided by law.


This patent is issued to correct the mineral reservation as to the above described land erroneously reserved in Patent No. 959052 dated May 5, 1925, and shall not operate to extend the trust period declared in said Patent No. 959052, as extended.
