To All to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

N<sup>o</sup> 834 — **Know Ye**, That, *Joel Cloud, assignee of Abraham Holladay* —

having deposited in the **General Land Office**, a Certificate of the Register of the **Land Office** at *Vincennes Indiana* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for *the north fractional sections* *fourteen, and fifteen* — in Township four North, of Range Two west, containing one hundred and sixty five acres, and twenty five hundredths of an acre —

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Vincennes* — by the Act of Congress, entitled “An Act providing for the sale of the Lands of the **United States**, in the Territory north-west of the **Ohio**, and above the mouth of Kentucky River,” and of the Acts amendatory of the same, **There is Granted**, by the United States, unto the said *Joel Cloud, and his heirs* — the fractional — lot, or section of Land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *fractional* lot, or section of Land, with the Appurtenances unto the said *Joel Cloud* —

*his* — heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, *I have caused these Letters to be made* **PATENT**, and the Seal of the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** to be hereunto affixed.
