WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Guthrie, Oklahoma, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of

JOSEPH N. CLOUD

has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the east half of the southwest quarter, the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section thirty-five in Township seventeen north of Range fourteen west of the Indian Meridian, Oklahoma, containing one hundred sixty acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Joseph N. Cloud

the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Joseph N. Cloud

and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, **Theodore Roosevelt**, President of the

United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
