To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting :

Whereas, By the 2d and 3d Articles of the Treaty concluded on the 30th day of May, A. D. 1854, by the Commissioner on the part of the United States, and certain Delegates of the United tribes of Kaskaskia and Peoria, Piankeshaw and Wea Indians, it is agreed that selections of lands shall be made for Individuals and Heads of families of said United tribes ;

And whereas, a Return, dated 31st August, 1858, from the Commissioner of Indian Affairs has been made to the General Land Office, accompanied by "Reservation Book A," whereby it appears that on the 28th August, 1858, the Secretary of the Interior approved for Peter Cloud

the following selection, viz :

The North West Quarter of Section Ten (160 Acres) The North East Quarter of Section Nine (160 Acres) Lot Number one in the North East Quarter of Section Ten (38.05 Acres) Lot Number Two in the North East Quarter of Section Ten (43.10 Acres) Lot Number Three in the North East Quarter of Section Ten (28.50 Acres) And the North West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Ten (40 Acres) All in Township Eighteen South of Range Twenty Three East of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Kansas containing in the aggregate Four Hundred and Fifty Nine Acres, and Forty Nine Hundredths of an Acre.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and pursuant to the provisions of the Treaty aforesaid, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents Do Give and Grant, unto the said Peter Cloud and to his heirs, the tracts of land above described, on the condition, as prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior under the provisions of the 11th Section of the Act of Congress, approved March 3d, 1859, (U. S. Statutes, Vol. 11, page 430.) that the said tracts "shall never be sold or conveyed, by the Grantee or his heirs, "without the consent of the Secretary of the Interior for the time being" TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tracts, or parcels of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Peter Cloud and to his heirs and assigns forever, with the condition aforesaid.

In testimony whereof, J. JAMES BUCHANAN, President of the United States, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
