KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Thomas Cloud, late a Private in Captain Wheat's Company Independent U S Mounted Volunteers

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in his favor, numbered 31526

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto Andrew Jurgesen, assignee of Mark Eugenheim, who was assignee of said Thomas Cloud, and to his heirs, The South West Quarter of Section Fifteen, in Township Twenty North, of Range Fifteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Green Bay, Wisconsin, containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Quarter section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

Andrew Jurgesen, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
