

# The United States of America.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, an Order by the Secretary of the Interior, accepting a relinquishment by the heirs of Pearl Cloud Man, an Indian of the Rosebud Reservation, to whom patent No. 581040, issued April 25, 1917, of all their right, title and interest therein, to the southwest quarter of Section twenty-four in Township thirty-seven north of Range twenty-six west of the Sixth Principal Meridian, South Dakota, in order that the same may be allotted to their son Amos Cloudman, in accordance with the provisions of Section three of the Act of June 25, 1910; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of said Act there has been allotted to the said Amos Cloudman, the southwest quarter of Section twenty-four in Township thirty-seven north of Range twenty-six west of the Sixth Principal Meridian, South Dakota, containing one hundred sixty acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the provisions of the Act of Congress approved February 8, 1887 and of the third Section of the Act of June 25, 1910, hereby declares that it does and will hold the land thus allotted (subject to all statutory provisions and restrictions) for the period of twenty-five years in trust for the sole use and benefit of the said Amos Cloudman, or in case of his decease, for the sole use of his heirs, according to the laws of the State or Territory where such land is located and that at the expiration of said period the United States will convey the same by patent to said Indian, or his heirs, as aforesaid, in fee, discharged of said trust and free from all charge or incumbrance whatsoever; and there is reserved from the lands hereby allotted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

This patent shall not operate to extend the trust period declared in said Patent No. 581040, dated April 25, 1917.
