To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Henry S W blood, Father and heir at law of Charles F blood deceased who served in place of Charles F Sutton private Captain Ewan's company First Regiment of Texas Mounted Volunteers,

having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor, numbered
69 668

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto *William Yates* Assignee of *said Henry S W blood,* and to his heirs, the *North East* Quarter, of *Section Seven,* in *Township Thirteen North,* of *Range Two West,* in the district of lands Subject to Sale at *Vandalia Illinois* containing *One hundred and Sixty acres*

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL,** which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned War-rant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *Quarter* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *William Yates, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
