with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South half of the North East quarter, and the South East quarter of the North West quarter of Section thirty, in Township forty eight North, of Range six West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Marquette Michigan containing one hundred and twenty acres.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said Warrant having been duly assigned to Archibald C. Thomson in whose favor said tract has been located.

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Archibald C. Thomson as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs.
