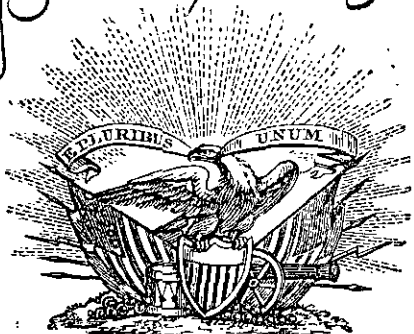

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 18,818 for 80 acres,

issued in favor of *Joseph Lloyd, Private in Captain Wadsworth's Company, Fifteenth Regiment Kentucky Militia War 1812*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the

*Lot numbered One, of the North West Quarter of Section One, in Township Two, of Range Seven East, in the district of lands subject to sale at Vandalia Illinois containing eighty acres,*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL:

*and whereas also the said warrant has been by the said Joseph Lloyd duly assigned unto Thomas Elliott*

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

*Thomas Elliott*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Thomas Elliott* and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
