KNOW YE, That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

Alexander Sarmant, Private in Captain Guthrie's Company, Eleventh Regiment United States Infantry

having deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE a WARRANT in his favor, numbered 43,923.

THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES; unto Marshall Lloyd, assignee of John Hay who was assignee of said Alexander Sarmant and to his heirs, Lot number One of the North East fractional quarter and the North half of the South fractional quarter Section Six, in Township Nineteen North, of Range Ten East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Danville Illinois, containing One hundred and Sixty Acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said parts of said section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Marshall Lloyd and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
