

# The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the Secretary of the Interior has been deposited in the General Land Office, partitioning the allotment of Jim Cabazon, an Indian of the Cabazon Reservation, and directing that a trust patent issue to Celestina (Celestine) Cabazon Saubel, for the north half of the north half of the Lot one of the southwest quarter of Section thirty in Township five south of Range eight east of the San Bernardino Meridian, California, containing nineteen acres and nine hundred thirty-five thousandths of an acre:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, hereby declares that it does and will hold the land above described for the period of twenty-five years in trust for the sole use and benefit of the said Indian, Celestina (Celestine) Cabazon Saubel,

subject to all statutory provisions and restrictions, as declared in the original trust patent covering the said land. And there is reserved from the lands hereby allotted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

This patent shall not operate to extend the trust period declared in patent No. 1013396 for said land dated March 10, 1928.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Franklin D. Roosevelt,
