JAMES MADISON, President of the United States of America,
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

KNOW YE, That Christopher Seabolt of Fairfield County Ohio

having deposited in the General Land-Office a Certificate of the Register of the Land-Office at *Chillicothe* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for the northwest quarter of Section Five of township Eighteen in Range Seventeen

of the lands directed to be sold at *Chillicothe* by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same: **There is granted,** by the United States, unto the said *Christopher Seabolt* the *quarter* lot or section of land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *quarter* lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Christopher Seabolt* his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land-Office to be hereunto affixed.
