JAMES MADISON, President of the United States of America,

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That *John Seabolt*, assignee of *Benjamin White*, having deposited in the General Land Office, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Shawneetown* whereby it appears that full Payment has been made for

*the Lot, number, one thousand, two hundred and eleven, in Shawneetown,*

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Shawneetown* by the Acts of Congress, relative to the disposal of the Public Lands in the ILLINOIS TERRITORY,

There is granted, by the United States, in pursuance of the Acts of Congress in that case provided, unto the said *John Seabolt*

the *Lot* Section of Land above described: To have and to hold

the said *Lot* Section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said

*John Seabolt, his* Heirs and Assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made

Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
