TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That John Seabolt assignee of Leonard White

having deposited in the General Land Office, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Shawneetown whereby it appears that full Payment has been made for the South West quarter of section twenty one in township one South of range seven East containing one hundred & sixty acres

of the Lands directed to be sold at Shawneetown by the Acts of Congress, relative to the disposal of the Public Lands in the ILLINOIS ~~TERRETTORY~~, There is granted, by the United States, in pursuance of the Acts of Congress in that case provided, unto the said John Seabolt the quarter Section of Land above described: To have and to hold the said quarter Section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said John Seabolt, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
