TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

KNOW YE, That *John Seabolt* assignee of *Leonard White*
having deposited in the General Land Office, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Shawneetown* whereby it appears that full Payment has been made for the North West quarter of section nine in township one South of range seven East containing one hundred & fifty acres

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Shawneetown* by the Acts of Congress, relative to the disposal of the Public Lands in ~~the~~ ILLINOIS ~~TERRITORY~~, There is granted, by the United States, in pursuance of the Acts of Congress in that case provided, unto the said *John Seabolt* the *quarter* Section of Land above described: To have and to hold the said *quarter* Section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said *John Seabolt his* Heirs and Assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
