THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, Warrant No. 39562 for 160 acres in favor of *George Seebolt Private in Captain Kelly's Company Kentucky Militia War 1812*

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon *the South West quarter of Section One in Township Seventy seven of Range Forty five, in the District of Council Bluffs Iowa containing one hundred and twenty two acres and seventy hundredths of an acre*

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL *the said Warrant having been assigned by the said George Seebolt to David W. Griffey in whose favor the said tract has been located*

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *David W. Griffey as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *David W. Griffey as assignee as aforesaid and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *James Buchanan* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
