The United States of America,

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate whereby it appears that full payment has been made according to the provisions of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1901, entitled "An act to supplement existing laws relating to the disposition of lands, and so forth" (31 Stat. 1093), by Charley Seibel for lot number nineteen, in block number eighteen, of the townsite of Hobart, Oklahoma, according to the official plat of the survey of said townsite;

NOW KNOW YE THAT THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, In consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the aforesaid act, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Charley Seibel, and to his heirs, the tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Charley Seibel and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Theodore Roosevelt, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
