WHEREAS

JACOB D. SEIBEL

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Dodge City, Kansas, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Jacob D. Seibel

according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the Lots six and seven and the east half of the southwest quarter of Section six in Township twenty-six south of Range forty-two west of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Kansas, containing one hundred fifty-one and eight-hundredths acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said lands, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor General, which said Tract has been purchased by the said

Jacob D. Seibel;

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Jacob D. Seibel and to his heirs, the said Tract above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Jacob D. Seibel and to his heirs and assigns forever.

And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof I, William H. Taft, President of the

United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
