according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for the North East quarter of Section thirty six, in Township thirty seven North of Range eight East of the Fourth Principal Meridian in Wisconsin, containing one hundred and sixty acres.

according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Peter F. Seibel

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: To HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Peter F. Seibel

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
