Williston, North Dakota, WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Thomas Seibold

has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter, the east half of the southwest quarter and the Lot seven of Section six in Township one hundred forty-nine north of Range ninety-eight west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, North Dakota, containing one hundred fifty-eight and ninety-seven-hundredths acres,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States; reserving, also, to the United States all coal in the lands so granted, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine, and remove coal from the same upon compliance with the conditions of and subject to the limitations of the Act of June 22, 1910 (36 Stat., 583).
