The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at **Helena, Montana,**

has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862,

"To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of

Archie Seybold

has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the **H.E. Survey No. 466, embracing a portion of, approximately, Sections nine and sixteen in Township fifteen south of Range nine west of the Montana Meridian, Montana, more particularly bounded and described as follows: Beginning at corner No. 1, from which the south quarter corner of Section thirty-three in Township fourteen south of Range nine west of the Montana Meridian, bears north two degrees thirty-three minutes ten seconds east ninety-eight and thirty-one-hundredths chains distant; thence south fifty-six degrees eight minutes east twenty-four and sixty-four-hundredths chains to corner No. 2; thence south five degrees thirty-nine minutes west sixty-five and forty-eight-hundredths chains to corner No. 3; thence north eighty-nine degrees forty-nine minutes west twenty-one and two-tenths chains to corner No. 4; thence north five degrees fourteen minutes east seventy-nine and fourteen-hundredths chains to corner No. 1, the place of beginning, containing one hundred fifty-four and seventy-one-hundredths acres,**

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the Surveyor-General:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claimant the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
