TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Know ye, That *Demsey Seybold*, of *Mason* county, *Kentucky* _____

having deposited in the **General Land Office**, a Certificate of the Register of the **Land Office** at *Vincennes* whereby it appears that full payment has been made for *the North East quarter of Section twenty nine, in township fourteen (North) of range seven (West) containing One hundred and sixty acres,* _____

of the lands directed to be sold at *Vincennes* _____ by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the **Ohio**, and above the mouth of Kentucky River," and of the acts amendatory of the same: **There is granted**, by the United States, unto the said *Demsey Seybold* _____ the *quarter* lot or section of Land above described: **To have and to hold** the said *quarter* lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said *Demsey Seybold*, his _____ heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made **Patent**, and the seal of the **General Land-Office** to be hereunto affixed.
