whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Edward E. Seybold

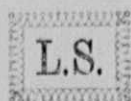
has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the East half of the North East quarter of section six, in Township twenty-three South, of Range two East, in the district of Lands subject to sale at Wichita, Kansas, containing seventy-nine acres, and seventy-seven hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Edward E. Seybold the tract of Land above described: To Have and to Hold the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Edward E. Seybold, and to his heirs and assigns forever:

In testimony whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the Twenty fifth day of July, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy six, and of the Independence of the United States the one hundred and first
