To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Homestead Certificate No. *113*

Whereas, there has been deposited in the **General Land Office** of the United States, a **CERTIFICATE** of the **Register of the Land Office at St. Peter**, whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual Settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of *Friedrich Seybold* has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the North half of the South East quarter of Section Thirty in Township One Hundred and Twelve North of Range Twenty six West in the District of lands subject to sale at St. Peter Minnesota containing Eighty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **General Land Office** by the *Surveyor General*.

**Now know ye,** That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said *Friedrich Seybold* the tract of Land above described: **To Have and to Hold** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Friedrich Seybold* and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *Ablyses Grant*, **PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the **General Land Office** to be hereunto affixed.
