Seybolds* and to his heirs, *the South half of the South West quarter, and the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section 24, and the North West quarter of the North West quarter of section 24, in Township five North of Range six West, in the District of Kansas, subject to sale at Edwardsville, Illinois, containing one hundred and fifty nine acres, and four hundredths of an acre*

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tracts have been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned Warrant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. TO HAVE AND

TO HOLD the said *parts of said* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

*James M. Seybolds, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
