To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS *James Seybold, of Pike County Illinois*

has deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** of the United States, a Certificate of the **REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE** at *Quincy,* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *James Seybold,*

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the South West quarter of Section nineteen in Township three, South of the base line, of Range four, West of the fourth principal Meridian, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Quincy, Illinois, containing one hundred and ninety five acres and sixty hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been purchased by the said *James Seybold,*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, **HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED,** and by these presents **DO GIVE AND GRANT,** unto the said *James Seybold*

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *James Seybold,*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
