

**The United States of America,**

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the Secretary of the Interior has been deposited in the General Land Office, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimant Elizabeth Glaude, formerly Elizabeth Poitra, a Turtle Mountain Chippewa Indian, for the northeast quarter of Section thirty-four in Township thirty-three north of Range thirty-two east of the Montana Meridian, Montana, containing one hundred sixty acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States. The land covered by this patent is not liable for any debt contracted prior to this date, as provided by Section 5 of the Act of February 8, 1887 (24 Stat., 388, 389), and the amendatory Acts of May 8, 1906 (34 Stat., 182), and June 21, 1906 (34 Stat., 325, 327).
