**KNOW YE,** That in pursuance of the Act of Congress, entitled "An act to raise for a limited time an additional military force, and for other purposes," approved February 11th, 1847,

*Frederick E. Clande, private Captain Prentiss' Company first Regiment Illinois Volunteers,*

having deposited in the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** a **WARRANT** in *his* favor numbered *6,134.*


**THERE IS THEREFORE GRANTED BY THE UNITED STATES, unto** *John J. Keenan,* assignee of said *Frederick E. Clande,* and to his heirs, the North West quarter of Section ten, in Township thirty-*xxx* North, of Range four East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Chicago, Illinois, containing one hundred and sixty acres,

according to the official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **GENERAL LAND OFFICE** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**, which said tract has been located in satisfaction of the above mentioned War-rant, in pursuance of the Act of Congress above mentioned, approved February 11th, 1847. **TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** the said *quarter* section of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said

*John J. Keenan, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
