Whereas, there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Wichita, Kansas, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Almira A. Cloud formerly Almira A. Ewing has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the lot numbered three, and the south-east quarter of the north-west quarter of section two, in township twenty-two south, of range seven west, in the district of lands subject to sale at Wichita, Kansas, containing eighty acres and thirty-six hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES, unto the said Almira A. Cloud the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Almira A. Cloud and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, Rutherford B. Hayes, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
