To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the Secretary of the Interior has been deposited in the General Land Office, directing that a fee simple patent issue to the claimant **Benjamin H. Cloud, heir of Pile of Clouds, a Nez Perce Indian,** for the north half of the east half of the northwest quarter of the north-east quarter of Section thirty-one in Township thirty-six north of Range three west of the Boise Meridian, Idaho, containing ten acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said claimant and to the heirs of the said claimant the Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States. The land covered by this patent is not liable for any debt contracted prior to this date, as provided by Section 5 of the Act of February 8, 1887 (24 Stat., 388, 389), and the amendatory Acts of May 8, 1906 (34 Stat., 182), and June 21, 1906 (34 Stat., 325, 327)
