## The United States of America,

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, an Order of the Secretary of the Interior has been deposited in the General Land Office, partitioning the allotment of Winyanwanjinawin or Wirxyanwanjinawin, or Sophia Derby, a Sisseton and Wahpeton Indian, and directing that a trust patent issue to Bessie Derby Cloud, Solomon Derby and Lucy Derby Cheroad, for the Lots three and four of Section seven in Township one hundred twenty-six north of Range fifty west and the east half of the southeast quarter of Section twelve in Township one hundred twenty-six north of Range fifty-one west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, in former Sisseton and Wahpeton Reservation, South Dakota, containing one hundred sixty-one and sixty-four-hundredths acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, hereby declares that it does and will hold the land above described for the period of twenty-five years (subject to all statutory provisions and restrictions, as declared in the original trust patent covering the said land) in trust for the sole use and benefit of the said Indians, according to their respective interest as set forth in said order: to Bessie Derby Cloud, an undivided one-third interest; to Solomon Derby, an undivided one-third interest; and to Lucy Derby Oneroad, an undivided one-third interest, and at the expiration of said period the United States will convey the same by patent to said Indians, or in case of their death, to their heirs, in fee, discharged of said trust and free from all charge or incumbrance whatsoever.

This patent shall not operate to extend the trust period declared in the patent for said land dated November 19, 1892, as extended.
