WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled an "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE,

Warrant No. 76, 217 for 120 acres, in favor of Durgan M. Cloud Private, Captain Otey's Company, Alabama Militia Cherokee Removal

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section One and the North half of the North East quarter of Section Two in Township Twenty five North of Range Two East in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Stevens Point, Wisconsin containing One Hundred and forty Seven acres and forty five hundredths of an Acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL the said Warrant having been assigned by the said Durgan M. Cloud to Burt Brett and James Hinman, in whose favor said tract has been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Burt Brett and James Hinman as assignees as aforesaid and to their heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Burt Brett and James Hinman, as assignees as aforesaid and to their

heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, James Buchanan PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
