Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 15833 for 80 acres, issued in favor of Catharine Hunter widow of Thomas Hunter deceased Corporal in Captain Hernandez Company fourth Regiment Tennessee Militia

West half of the South West quarter of Section nine in Township Twenty Three of Range Thirty in the District of Lands Subject to Sale at Springfield Missouri containing Eighty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: Which has been assigned to El Nathan D Cloud

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said El Nathan D Cloud

the Tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said El Nathan D Cloud and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
