the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said George A. Cloud and to his heirs and assigns forever; and ~~there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.~~
