Whereas, there has been deposited in the **General Land Office** of the United States, a **CERTIFICATE** of the Register of the Land Office at Concordia Kansas,

whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain;" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of George G. Cloud

has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South West quarter of the South East quarter of Section thirty three of Township five South and the West half of the North East quarter, and the North East quarter of the North East quarter of Section four, in Township six South of Range five East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Concordia Kansas containing one hundred and forty nine acres and thirty eight hundredths of an acre.

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the **General Land Office** by the **SURVEYOR GENERAL**.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the **UNITED STATES** unto the said George G. Cloud the tract of Land above described: **To Have and to Hold** the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said George G. Cloud and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony whereof, J. W. P. P. P., PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the **Seal of the General Land Office** to be hereto affixed.
