To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, Henry O. Cloud, of Bienville Parish, Louisiana

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Natchitoches, Louisiana, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Henry O. Cloud

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," and the acts supplemental thereto, for

the South half of the South East quarter of Section nine the South West quarter of the South West quarter of Section ten and the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section fifteen in Township fourteen North of Range seven West of Louisiana Meridian in Louisiana, containing one hundred and fifty eight acres and thirty nine hundredths of an acre

according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Henry O. Cloud

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Henry O. Cloud

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said

Henry O. Cloud and to his heirs and assigns forever.
