To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, There has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States an Order of the Secretary of the Interior directing that a fee simple patent issue to HENRY ROE CLOUD, heir of White Ox, or Chae ska kaw, a Winnebago Indian, for the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section fifteen in Township twenty-six north of Range six east and the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section fourteen in Township twenty-six north of Range seven east of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Nebraska, containing one hundred sixty acres:

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, HAS GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DOES GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Henry Roe Cloud and to his heirs, the lands above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Henry Roe Cloud and to his heirs and assigns, forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, William H. Taft, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
