United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Little Rock, Arkansas

Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Little Rock, Arkansas, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Ida K. Linam, formerly Ida K. Cloud has been established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the South East quarter of the North West quarter, the East half of the South West quarter and the North West quarter of the South East quarter of section twenty-eight in Township three South of Range seventeen West of the Fifth Principal Meridian in Arkansas, containing one hundred and sixty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

Now know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Ida K. Linam* the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Ida K. Linam* and to her heirs and assigns forever.
