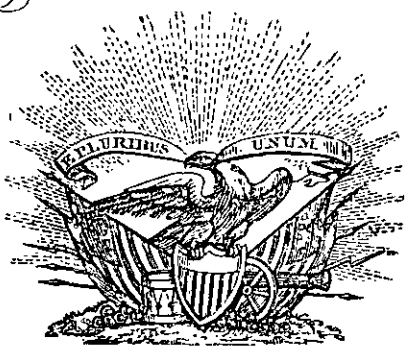

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 5989 for *One hundred and Sixty* acres, issued in favor of *James M. Cloud private in Captain Peck's company Tennessee Volunteers Florida War*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *South East quarter of the North East Quarter and the North East quarter of the South East quarter of Section thirty six township two of Range seven East and two thirds of the North West quarter of fractional section thirty one in township two of Range eight East in the district of Lands subject to Sale at Huntsville Alabama containing one hundred and fifty two acres and seventy five hundredths of an acre* according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *which said Warrant has been assigned to Charles M. Cross junior*

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Charles M. Cross junior*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Charles M. Cross junior and his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Millard Fillmore* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
