WHEREAS, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved March 3, 1855, entitled "An Act in addition to certain Acts granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the United States," there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE,

with evidence that the same has been duly located upon The East half of the South East quarter of section thirteen and the North East quarter of the North East quarter of section twentyfour in Township sixtyfour of range twentyseven in the district of Lands formerly subject to sale at Plattaburg now Bonoille Missouri containing one hundred and twenty acres

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL The said warrant having been assigned by the said John R. Cloud to Robert Beverly in whose favor said tract has been located

NOW KNOW YE, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Robert Beverly as assignee as aforesaid and to his heirs

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Robert Beverly as assignee as aforesaid and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
